- 2. Introduction and welcome to our guest speakers, Brian Kelmar and Carol Nesteikis who are co-founders of <u>DTHREE</u> Decriminalize Developmental Disabilities. As President, Brian collaborates with families of autistic individuals who are entangled in the criminal justice system. He partners with organizations in the US, Canada, and the UK. As the lead advocate for criminal justice reform, he has championed five legislative bills related to this cause, all of which have been signed into law. Carol is the Vice-President of DTHREE. Her son has an intellectual disability; her family was caught up in the criminal legal system in 2012 and along the way they found many more families across this country suffering the same nightmare. DTHREE is an organization by families for families.
- 3. Discussion and group questions.
  - Brian gave a <u>presentation</u> and reviewed the background of DTHREE, explaining the need for change with laws and discrimination against people with developmental disabilities. He discussed the differences between developmental disabilities and mental illness and the failures of the criminal justice system. His advocacy has led to changes in laws in Virginia for prevention, intervention, and diversion. Work is continuing to roll out for reform across the US.
  - Carol spoke about her journey and how she became involved in giving a voice to
    those with developmental disabilities and their families. She has collaborated with
    various advocates and organizations to bring awareness to the many issues
    surrounding the challenges facing families and individuals in navigating the criminal
