 - Board members meet monthly to collaborate on organizational business, review current projects, and work on processes and applications to be implemented.
 - Shawn and Kathy D.V. attended an Advocacy Bootcamp hosted by the <u>Michigan</u> <u>League of Public Policy</u> on 8/14/2025 and they both spoke about the conference.
