- Shawn is in touch with Kathie Gourlay as a potential guest speaker for restorative justice. Kathie heads up the support group <u>Michigan</u> <u>Citizens for Justice</u>.
- Jenny is still keeping in touch with <u>Anthony Gay</u>, <u>Tosha Smith Mills</u>, and <u>Chris</u> <u>Pelloski</u> on the possibilities of them being a guest at one of our upcoming meetings and she will update when any follow-up is received.
- Loved Ones Storytelling Project Betty was unable to attend the meeting and will update at our next meeting.
- Communications Committee Update:
 - Gail sent a thank you letter from the group to the ALI in support of their approval of the proposed changes to the Model Penal Code for Sexual Assault and Related Offenses. The Communications Committee will work on a revision of that letter for individual letters to be made available on the website.
 - Discussion about keeping the group informed with any additional information regarding this initial stage of approval to the code and possible future follow up with another letter campaign.
- Committees Discussion:
 - Shawn reported on our need to create more committees to help delegate tasks and responsibilities for advocacy CTAs and to encourage member participation.
 - Suggestions for the type of committees needed include Research (for project support), Fundraising, and Marketing/PR (for developing media contacts and lining up speakers and guests for our meetings).
 - Shawn will head the Marketing/PR committee. We will need volunteers for each committee and people to head the Research and the Fundraising committees. This will be an ongoing process with group involvement and ideas to encourage group members to become more proactive in our projects.
 - Jackie, Pammy, and Kim have all volunteered to be a part of the Research Committee!

"UNITED VOICES for SEX OFFENSE REFORM" General Meeting Minutes Tuesday, March 15, 2022, 7:30 PM EST / Via ZOOM

- Shawn announced the new moderators for our Facebook group who will work with the admins to ensure that our page stays consistent with our advocacy focus. Kimberly, Jackie and Nafisa will be introduced to the group and begin on April 1, 2022. Thanks to all three of them for volunteering their time! The need for moderators is an indication of how quickly our group is growing and how active it is becoming!
- Shawn attended Caution Click's recent meeting and discussed how they had utilized our First Step Act <u>individual scripted letter</u> for a mail blast from their group. One person in the meeting asked her how we are doing so well getting our name out there! The group discussed how we can continue to get our voices heard and thoughts about how we can get people who are not impacted by these issues to pay attention to what we are doing.
- Shawn introduced information and led a discussion about the event in Washington DC to be held March 5 through March 7, 2023. This event calls attention to the 20th anniversary of the Smith v. Doe SCOTUS decision (538 U.S. 84). To this day, that decision causes severe harm to registered persons and their families.
 - This conference/event is called "<u>Teamwork Makes the Dreamwork</u>". As part of the conference, there will be pre-arranged appointments to visit Capitol Hill to speak with Congressional representatives or staff members. In-depth training will be provided by ACSOL Executive Director Janice Bellucci on how to effectively communicate in these meetings.
 - <u>Pre-registration</u> is open now and everyone who can attend is encouraged to pre-register now! The early sign-up deadline is June 30, 2022. The \$20.00 registration fee will count as \$40.00 toward the cost of the conference. The \$20.00 fee is nonrefundable and will, in part, finance a scholarship fund to help with expenses for those who cannot afford it.
 - Conference dates are Sunday, March 5, and Monday March 6, 2023. You can see the conference schedule <u>HERE</u>.
 - The main event is a vigil which will be held on the steps of the Supreme Court of the United States on Tuesday, March 7, 2023, which is the 20th anniversary date of the Smith v Doe SCOTUS decision.
 - This is an exciting and unique opportunity for all of us to get involved, to personally be a part of an important organized event, to meet advocates from other groups, and to meet up with others from our group!
 - We will post in the group to make everyone aware of this event, encourage attendance, and coordinate meeting up with group members who attend.
